Use a portion of your Promise scholarship funds while still in high school to obtain post-secondary credits ahead of the game. The remaining balance of your Promise scholarship will be waiting, if you choose to continue your education.

2-4 Workforce Certifications

Obtain stackable industry certifications to ensure that you are work-ready.

A Driver's License

A driver's education course will be provided so that you are able to compete for the jobs and post-secondary programs that require a driver's license.

Connections to Employers

Obtain the skills and training necessary to be eligible for high-needs jobs in our area. Gain connections to local employers to match your skills to the current demands of the job market.
